ENGLISH

This week in writing we have started a new narrative unit based on the Spudewick Chronicles film and comparing it to the book. After watching the film explored similarities and differences to the book. We then focused on planning a setting descriptions using a scene from the film, including lots of adjectives, nouns, verbs and adverbs. We ended the week by starting to write our setting descriptions using high level vocabulary and sentences. We remembered to use all of the information on our plans. MATHS

In math's this week we have continued to focus on length and perimeter. We started the week by subtracting different lengths and using our prior knowledge to find the answers. We then moved on to perimeter. We explored what perimeter was by measuring the length of different shapes before calculating the perimeter of a shape. We used our previous learning and even challenged ourselves to convert from cm to mm.
