LITERACY

In Literacy we have been practising our sentence skills.

We have supported our learning by:

- Remembering what is needed for a good sentence – capital letter, finger space and full stop.
- Using our key word knowledge and phonics skills when writing each sentence.
- Rereading our work to make sure it makes sense.
- We wrote sentences about all the things we have enjoyed about Kingfisher class. We enjoyed looking at all the photographs and how we have changed.

In phonics we have been recapping all the skills we have learnt from phase 4 phonics. We have been using these skills to write different words.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics we have been working on our problem solving skills.

We have supported our learning by:

- Recapping what we need to know about a problem.
- Explain how we know if it is a subtraction or addition problem.
- Explaining how we can work out the answer and what we need to do.
- Using different resources to show our problem solving skills.
- Writing down our problems as an equation.
